Documented vessels are excluded from numbering. <b>TOTAL BOAT REGISTRATIONS:</b> There are a total of 394,575 numbered recreational vessels and 356 numbered commercial vessels for a sub-total of 394,931 numbered vessels. Each registration is valid for three boating seasons. Approximately one-third of the registrations expire March 1 of each year. In addition, there are 14,000 alternative registration vessels, 2435 documented vessels, and 5576 livery vessels registered for a grand total of 416,942 registered vessels.  <i>Note: The definition of personal watercraft as detailed in the NASBLA Model Act for Personal Watercraft (approved 9-21-05) was used to determine the cut-off length (16 feet) for a personal watercraft versus a jet boat (motorboat).</i>					Commercial Passenger:		Commercial Fishing:		Commercial Other:
